## What is Show Me Ethanol doing to address COVID-19?

- We are focused on keeping crew to crew isolation where possible.
- Visitors are allowed only under strict guidelines, and when on property are assigned a specific contact person to interact with in order to limit contact with the Show Me Ethanol population.
- Control Room operators are to be assigned to different control rooms, alternating between the 2 that we have (energy center and main)
- To promote on-site work isolation, we have set up a temporary lab and split operator samples based on the abilities in the two labs. For now, instead of Cook and D&E operators, we have Operator A and B, doing tasks that can be accomplished in the corresponding Lab A or Lab B. The employees on shift should effectively not have close contact through their shifts
- In all cases, if employees are within 6' of each other, face coverings are recommended but optional.
- Utility vehicles have been placed back in service. Please use the provided sanitizer to clean before and after use.
- Break areas are limited to strict separation requirements.
- Employees who choose to participate in large gatherings or travel during a declared medical pandemic are required to notify the company and, on a case-by-case basis, may be required to self-isolate or take other protective measures such as wear a mask for 14 days after their return. These activities and trips should be discussed prior to the event so appropriate precautions, PTO planning, and plan of return are established.
